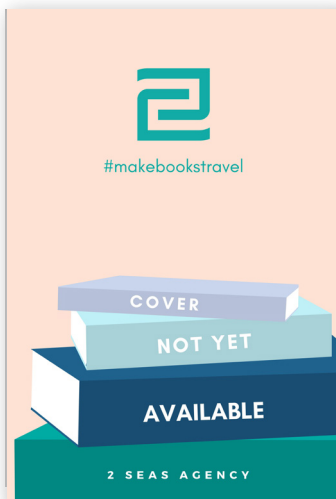

Dance

A Philosophical Investigation

Ritual dances, sexual ones, war dances or festive ones... We don't know of any human society without dancing. As an activity it is an anthropological invariable, and, along with singing, is surely the oldest art form.

Why do we feel the need to dance? What affects us so deeply about the succession of movements? What distinguishes a dance movement from an ordinary, everyday one? What does dancing teach us about our ability to yield to rhythm, to free us from shame? About the connection between discipline and freedom?

In order to write this essay, the philosopher was granted exceptional permission to go behind the scenes at the Paris Opera, which is famous for its ballet company, and to attend the rehearsals of the principal dancers Ludmila Pagliero and Stéphane Bullion. He describes their daily work and their stunning paths, and strives to put their bodies' physical intelligence into words.

His philosophical investigation gets as close as possible to the mysteries of this ephemeral art and intensifies our pleasure as spectators by opening our eyes to what's at stake in dance.

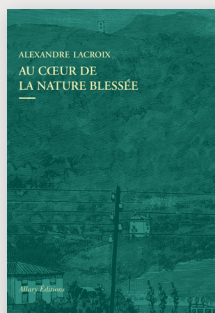

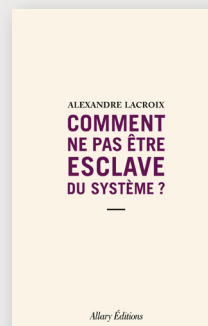

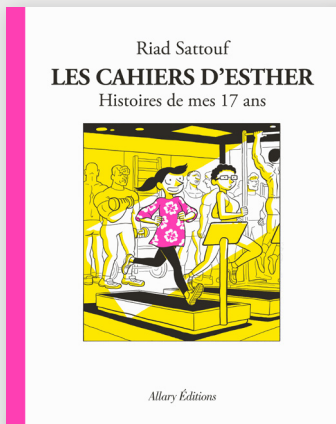

Esther's Notebooks vol. 8

Based on true stories told by Esther A., *Esther's Notebooks* draw us into the daily life of a girl talking about school, friends, family, and pop stars.

Allary Editions publishes one volume per year, nine volumes in total. Each volume covers one year in the life of Esther, from her 10th through to her 18th year, and each contains 52 stories for the 52 weeks of the year.

Volume 1 (10 years old): Esther is 10 years old. Who are Tal, Kendji Girac, and the Hotheads? What are the criteria of beauty that make young boys and girls popular? What can you do when your friends have more money than you do? How did Esther's class feel about the attacks in Paris in January 2015? What do you do if you're worried about your breast size?

Volume 2 (11 years old): Esther is 11 years old. She tells us about the birth of her little brother, the terrorist attacks, the boys she is in love with, religious discussions with her best friend, her teacher with dwarfism, her mother who suddenly gained weight, her idiot big brother and her father, that hero...

Volume 3 (12 years old): Esther is a 12-year-old student in a prestigious college in the center of Paris. She is now a preteen! The presidential elections, her first cell phone, her hamster Manuela, the arrival of acne, her conspiring brother, her left-wing partisan father, her far-right voting grandmother, President Macron, the Illuminati, and her love for sausage-apricot cake... Esther talks about everything!

Volume 4 (13 years old): Esther is now 13, she leaves childhood and enters adolescence... In this volume Esther talks about her dental braces, the French #metoo movement, her long-gone dreams, her secret boyfriend Ben, her friends, her family...

Volume 5 (14 years old): Esther is now 14 and starts to take an interest in politics (just a little), wonders how we can live normally while the homeless sleep in the streets, and learns Spanish, thanks to her penpal Nacho. Of course she listens to Angèle, and imagines that all the young people of the world will save the Earth by joining hands.

Volume 6 (15 years old): It's the year Esther turns 15 and is entering ninth grade, her last year of middle school! She reconnects with her BFFs Éva and Léa, puts up with some overly feminine girls who got left back, organizes her first big birthday party (with alcohol!), tries a cigarette and (finally) creates her Instagram profile, which inevitably attracts psychopaths.

Then everything gets thrown into chaos by the coronavirus... it's lockdown time.

Volume 7 (16 years old): Esther is in tenth grade! This is the year she turns 16. Everyone smokes; it's almost like a "drug empire." Some of her friends are anti-vax. She still gets vaccinated, and by a fireman better looking than Timothée Chalamet. Her body changes – not because of the vaccine. She has to make her choices and invent her future life. To make some pocket money, she starts babysitting and even becomes a camp counselor.

Volume 8 (17 years old): Esther is 17 years old. It's almost time for her final French exams and Esther is wondering about her future: why not give up her studies altogether, in fact, LOL? And become a bookseller? To live among books? But apparently, it pays less than being an Instagrammer, so it's tricky... And then Putin, the bald dictator, attacks Ukraine, and war breaks out. What if it happened to us in France too?

Final **Volume 9 (18 years old)** is forthcoming in 2024.

Riad Sattouf

Riad Sattouf is a cartoonist and filmmaker. Born in 1978, he spent his childhood between Libya, Syria and Brittany. He has been drawing comics for 20 years and published more than 20 books. Sattouf is one of the few graphic novel authors to have won the Fauve d'or at the Angoulême festival twice (for *Pascal Brutal* 3 in 2010 and *The Arab of the Future* 1 in 2015).

The Arab of the Future

The Complete Series

The internationally acclaimed bestselling graphic novel series is now available in one single volume.

In the same vein as *Maus* by Art Spiegelman and Marjane Satrapi's *Persepolis*, *The Arab of the Future* is an autobiographical and political graphic novel. Raised by a paranoid Syrian father who dreamed of being a dictator, it is with devastating humor and great sensitivity that Riad Sattouf talks about his childhood and the story of his family in the Libya of Mouammar Kadhafi and the Syria of Hafez el Assad.

Volume 1 (2014) covers the period from 1978 to 1984: from birth to the age of six, little Riad is shuttled between Libya, Brittany and Syria.

Volume 2 (2015) tells the story of his first year of school in Syria (1984-1985).

Volume 3 (2016) sees him between the ages of six and nine, the time he becomes aware of the society he is growing up in (1985-1987).

With 288 pp., **volume 4** (2019) is longer than the other volumes and covers 1987 to 1992. It includes an overthrow of his father's power, and is the most dramatic volume yet.

Volume 5 (2020) covers the period from 1992 to 1994.

Volume 6 (November 2022) covers the years 1994-2011. This is the last volume in the series.

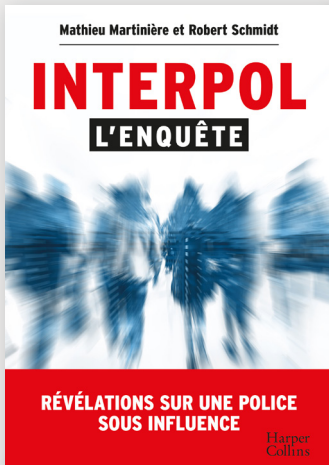

Massot Éditions is directed by Florent Massot, independent editor for 35 years and discoverer of numerous authors in France. 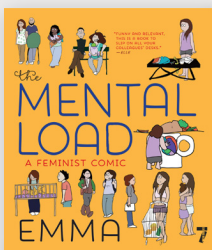

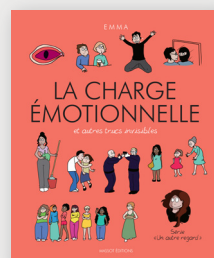

The Mental & Emotional Load

"I read lots of things and then categorize them by theme. After a while, I start to feel like a particular theme should be shared with the public. I summarize the theme and anchor the theoretical idea in our private lives, in the personal experiences that allow me to touch each reader. That's how I finally became interested in social politics, which I had always found obnoxious before. I came across scenes from my own life in feminist articles I read. There was no way that these things could have happened to so many women all over the world without a connection! Then I read articles explaining how categories of people experience similar things: there's a system. Using these events we go through alone and showing people that they are in fact shared experiences reveals the importance of the context. From there, we can change the context to change our personal experiences."

Cypry sets out to find the person who has been violently attacking muggers in Paris (cliffhanger from Vol.1), only to discover that it's a gang of three women. These dangerous, subversive women fascinate her, and soon encourage Cypry to join them.

Cypry finds herself once again caught up in a whirlwind of violence, this time not of her own making. All this while living a double life, frequenting private California clubs and hosting lavish affairs for Hollywood stars and military dignitaries in his mansion on the Los Angeles Bird Streets.
