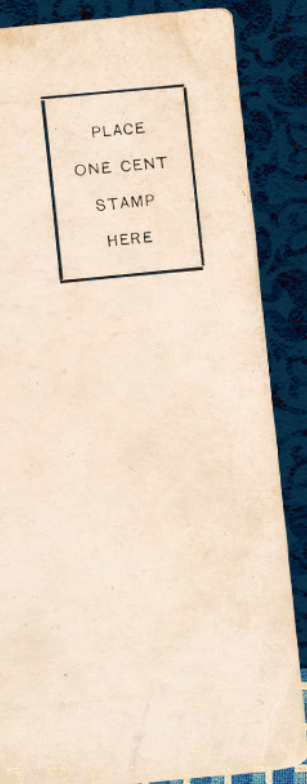

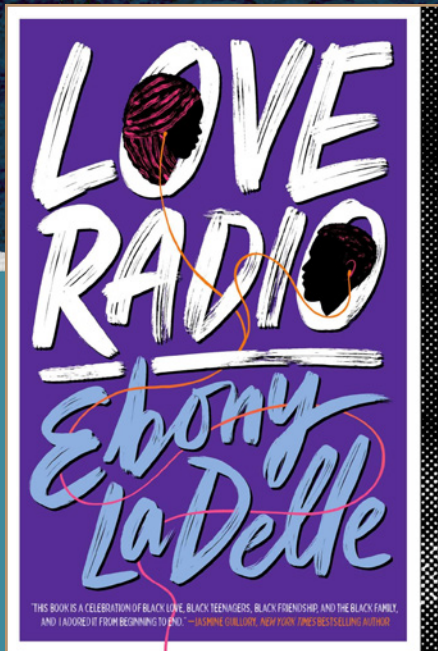
When an active shooter is reported on campus, and a male incel group claims to want to make the Chancellor and women pay, the campus goes on lockdown and everyone must shelter-in-place.

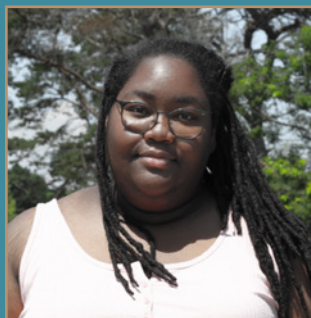

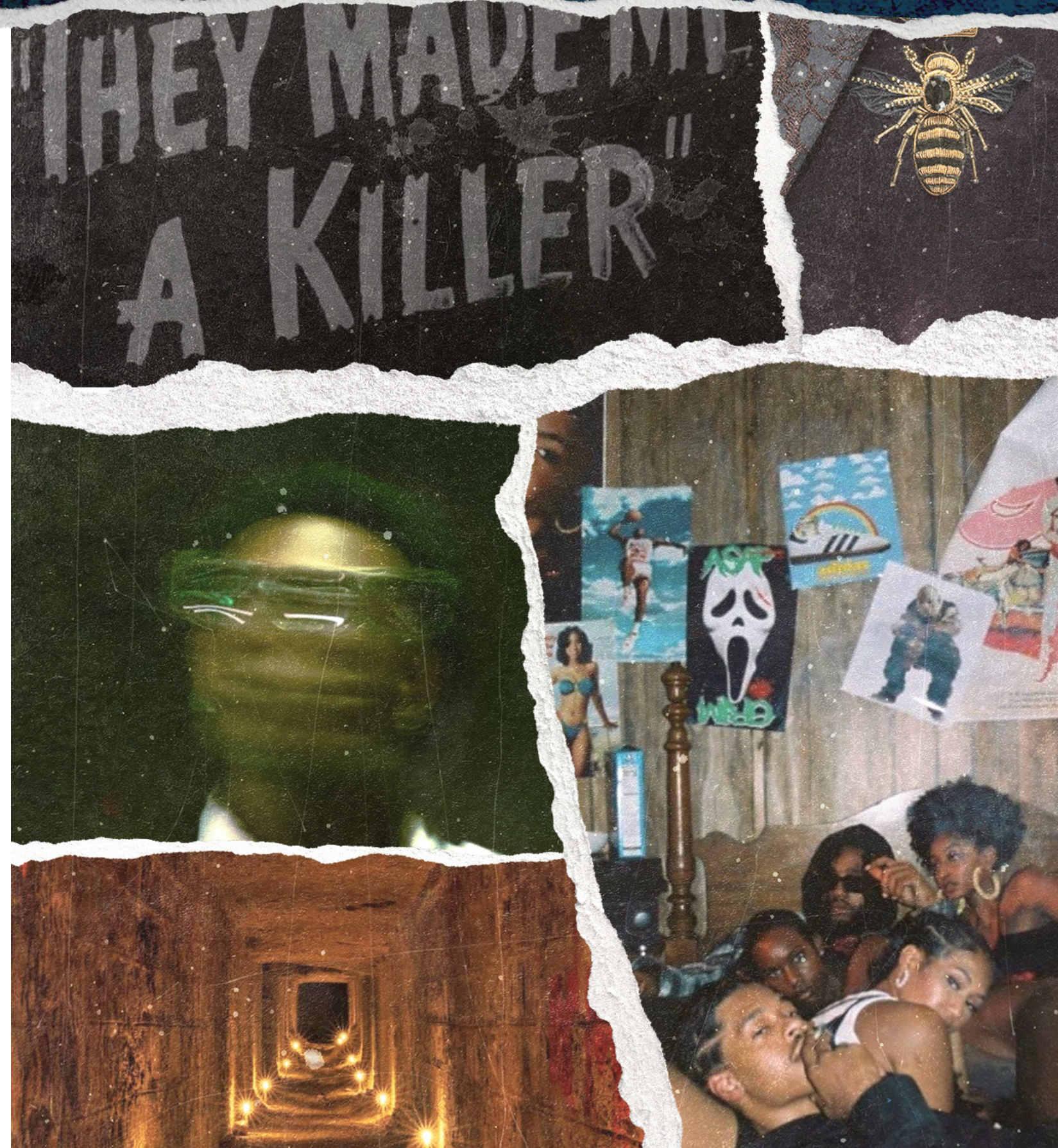
