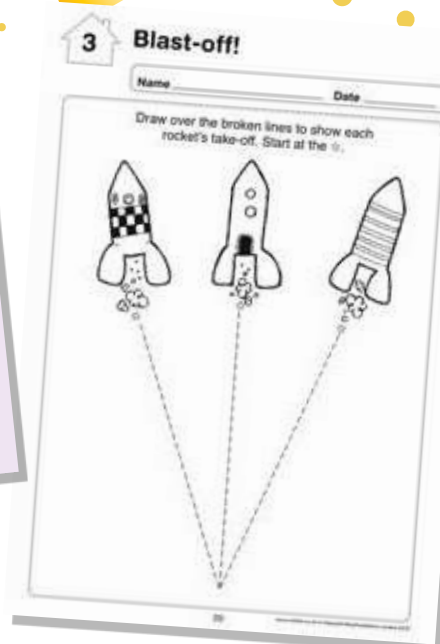
The bank of activities for each project is the vehicle for teaching speaking and listening skills, early reading skills (phonics), early writing skills and related reinforcement. There are lots of suggestions for incorporating more cross-curricular and creative activities within the topic.



The **Workbook** is phonics-based and linked to the reading and writing EYFS goals. It can be used for early writing practice as well as to support teacher judgement of completion of EYFS goals and outcomes.



The **Handwriting Resource Pack** introduces children to the fine motor movements and pencil control that will be necessary for the formation of letters and patterns. It provides practice in moving from left to right, keeping within 'tramlines' and making up-and-down and curved movements.



The **Teacher's Guide** provides a framework for an educational and creative literacy programme with a storytelling focus for EYFS planning and teaching. The guide contains 18 story-led or poem-led teaching sequences that interweave the main EYFS literacy areas of communication, reading, writing and phonics into interesting and fun activities for the children.

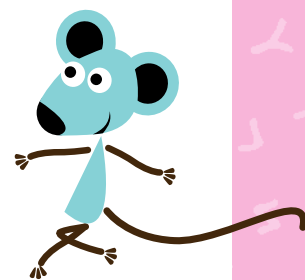

What to do - identifying children for daily individual support sessions

Use the Letters and Sounds assessments (every six weeks), as well as assessment within the daily lesson, to identify children who need either individual or group keep-up. Do not let children fall behind - take action as soon as possible.

Use the assessment again after three weeks to check that these children have filled their gaps.
