





But Abioye is getting to know her people and their needs, making changes along the way. When the chiefs call for a new king, the villagers refuse to vote for any of the men. Under Abioye's rule, the village has flourished and, for the first time, the village claims a female king. This empowering story explores themes of service in leadership, gaining respect rather than demanding it, and gender equality.

Our Woolly Bear

One day, a curious friend shows up in Edie and Lou's vegetable garden. Woolly Bear, a fuzzy black-and-orange caterpillar, is just the quiet friend the sisters need: a tiny adventurer that quickly becomes part of the family. But then the seasons begin to change—leaves fall first, then snow. Will their new friend stick around or disappear? This story explores themes of outdoor discovery and playful curiosity, offering a welcome reminder that beauty often surfaces in small, slow moments, and that change persists even when the world seems still.



One Giant Leap

A child gets dressed to go out on a snowy morning: first a coat, then boots and gloves, and finally a hat. Stepping outside, the child transforms into a colourful astronaut venturing out into a stark, dark landscape, and presses heavy boots into the ground. The little astronaut sets off and is undeterred by the obstacles and creatures they meet as they climb, jump, and plant a triumphant flag. An ode to a child's imagination, this wordless book takes us along one child's exciting journey to show us how something as simple as a walk to school can become an out-of-this-world adventure.



This fearsomely funny sequel to *Princess Pru and the Ogre on the Hill* is an unconventional fairy tale about empathy, inclusivity, and being mindful of the things we sometimes take for granted.






The Noisy Puddle A Vernal Pool Through the Seasons






Otis & Peanut Forever and Ever




Three City Kitties







Bee & Flea and the Fall Fiasco


