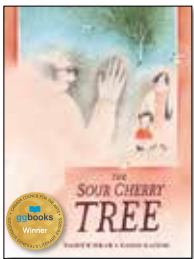

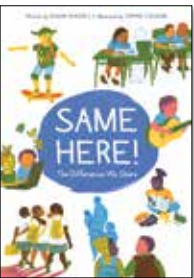

The Little Regent

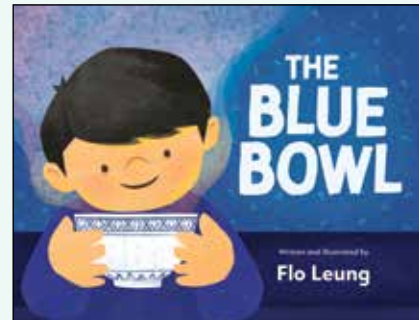

Under Abioye's rule, the village has flourished and, for the first time, the village claims a female king. This empowering story explores themes of service in leadership, gaining respect rather than demanding it, and gender equality.

## The Blue Bowl

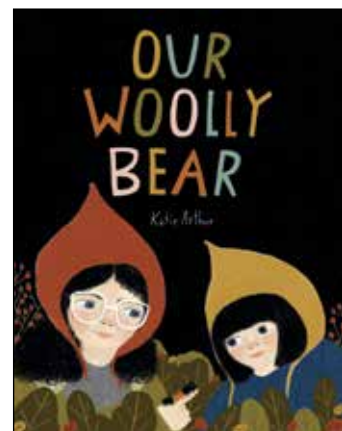

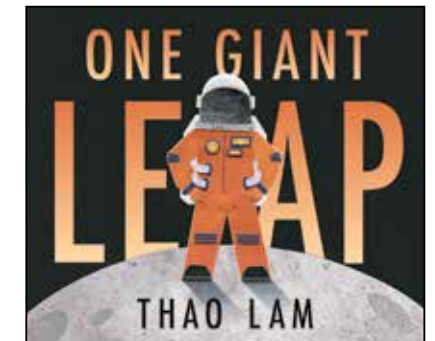

An ode to a child's imagination, this wordless book takes us along one child's exciting journey to show us how something as simple as a walk to school can become an out-of-this-world adventure.

## The Weird Sisters: A Coop, Some Goop, and a Sandwich

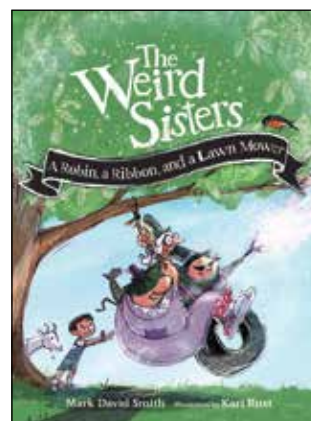
