
Picture book adaptation from children's literature writer and Hans Christian Andersen Award winner, Cao Wenxuan (4 Titles)

Born in 1954, Cao is an acclaimed novelist of children's literature, best known for winning the prestigious Hans Christian Andersen Award in 2016. He was the first Chinese author to ever receive the award. In announcing the award, the International Board for Young People's Jury said Cao "writes beautifully about the complex lives children facing great challenges. He is a deeply committed writer, whose own difficult childhood has been deeply influential on his writing in which there are no easy answers." In 2015, Cao's *Dingding and Dangdang* series was selected as one of IBBY's Outstanding Books for Young People with Disabilities. In 2017, his book *Bronze and Sunflower* was selected as a Kirkus finalist and a New York Times Notable Children's Book. Cao's English translator of all his works Helen Wang won the 2017 Marsh Award for Children's Literature in Translation. A professor of Chinese literature at Peking University, Cao's work has been translated into English, French, German, Italian, Russian, Japanese, and Korean. Several of his works have also been adapted into films. His other works include *Dragonfly Eyes*, *The Grass House*, *Summer*, etc.





Gui Tuzi (Illustrator)



Huang is an author of children's books and picture books and a psychotherapist. Some of her works have been adapted into cartoon series and have won several Hsin Yi Awards..




